We write today **in support** of Docket Number DHS-2005-0057 establishing the new Port of Entry at Sacramento, California and the realignment of the port limits of the Port of Entry at San Francisco, California.

In 2002, the Sacramento region welcomed Mexicana Airlines with non-stop service to Guadalajara continuing on to Mexico City. We have seen this service expand since 2002 adding both Morelia and Leon and the beach city of Los Cabos. This additional international service reflects the vibrant diverse economy we have in this region and the establishment of the Port of Sacramento to handle all our international activity is a step in the right direction and reflective of the emerging international importance of our region.


The Sacramento region is the financial, political and cultural hub of the Central Valley and is expected to grow to 2.4 million by 2010. This rate of growth is expected to outpace the growth of nearly all other major metropolitan areas in California, as well as California itself. This growth will naturally be reflected by increased activity at our airport and increased international destinations offered to Northern California passengers.

Finally, Sacramento International is one of only a handful of airports nation-wide that has attracted five new air carriers since 9/11/01. It is clear that the success of the airport and the growth of the region will drive the further expansion of international passenger flights at Sacramento International and the potential for international cargo at Mather Airport has never been greater. The establishment of the Port of Entry in Sacramento is a worthy reflection of this success and is viewed as an additional resource to further enhance the economic development of the region.
